2 Introduction

Maharashtra State Excise Department (MSED) is responsible for collection of excise revenue and enforcement of the Excise Acts & Rules in the state to regulate the manufacture, transport, sale, import and export of liquor and other intoxicating substances.

The major objectives of the MSED are:

- 1. Revenue collection on human consumable liquors.
- 2. Regulation and control of excisable articles.
- 3. Eradication of illicit distillation, transportation, possession, and sale of liquor.
- 4. Prevent sale or smuggling of spurious and duty evaded liquor.

Maharashtra State Excise Department invites sealed Expression of Interest (EoI) from professionally & financially sound and duly registered companies /agencies /organizations which possess capabilities for implementation of AI/ML based CCTV Surveillance system. Through this, the department intends to identify solutions available for implementation and vendors which can undertake any future work regarding this for liquor vending licensee premises under jurisdiction of MSED.

3 Tentative Objectives of the EOI

- The main objective to undertake this project is to restrict entry of non-eligible customers in the liquor vending licensee premises and restriction on serving alcohol post prescribed working hours in the liquor vending licensee premises.
- So, to cater this, MSED intends to implement an AI/ML based CCTV solution which will determine/tell the age of person entering in the liquor vending licensee premises and in case of any non-eligible customer (age-wise) entering the restaurant it will trigger an alert which will be then sent to the respective premise's Manager and designated Excise officials (concerned Area Excise officers) via an app/system. The solution should also trigger an alert if a liquor is getting served at a liquor vending licensed premises post prescribed working hours. These alerts will be then sent to the respective premise's Manager and designated Excise officials (concerned Area Excise officers) via an app/system.
- The system should have dashboard and mobile app for displaying real time alarms to the aforesaid users.
- The system should have an option given to Excise officials to seek information from Manager (ask query) on any given incident/alert.
- The system should have a reporting feature/dashboard like total alerts in week, actioned alerts, unactioned alerts etc. The system should be secure, fast and integrate with any IP based CCTV cameras.
